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### Instructions to the Candidate

1. A printed copy of this Admit Card must be presented for verification along with the original (not photocopy or scanned copy) valid photo identification proof which is mentioned in the admit card as well. In case of poor quality of photo on ID proof or electronic ID, candidate MUST bring an additional recent valid photo ID also (For example: Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID, Aadhaar Card, College ID, Employee ID, Driving License).
2. Admit Card is considered to be valid only if both the photograph and signature are clear. To ensure this, print this admit card on A4 sized paper using laser printer, preferably in colour.
3. Candidates will be permitted to appear for the examination ONLY after verification of their credentials by the centre officials.
4. To facilitate the verification of their identity, candidates must report at the examination venue at least 60 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination.
5. Candidates will be permitted to occupy their seats 40 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination. Candidates can login and start reading the instructions 20 minutes before start of the examination.
6. CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO login 30 minutes after start of the exam.
7. Candidates will NOT be permitted to leave the examination hall before end of exam.
8. During the examination, a virtual scientific calculator will be available on the computer screen, which may be used for the numerical calculations.
9. Candidates should NOT bring any charts/tables/papers/books/sheets into the examination hall. Scribble pad will be provided for the rough work. Before using it, candidates must write their individual name and registration number. The candidate can possess ONLY one scribble pad at any point of time. Before taking the second scribble pad, if required, the first scribble pad MUST be returned to the invigilator. At the end of the examination, scribble pad must be returned to the invigilator.
10. Personal calculators, any kind of watches, wallets, mobile phones or any other electronic/communication devices are STRICTLY PROHIBITED inside the examination hall. GATE authorities are not responsible for the safe keep of candidate's personal belongings.
11. During the examination, candidates may be checked for possession of any of the prohibited items. If the candidate is found to possess any of the prohibited items, candidate will be debarred from the examination and/or subjected to disciplinary action, which may include ban from appearing in future examinations.
12. At the time of examination, in case there is a restriction on movements in certain areas, candidates can use this admit card as a pass for the movement.
13. Candidates must bring their own pen, pencil, transparent water bottle and pocket size hand sanitizer. Without proper face MASK in place, the entry of the candidate in the examination centre shall be PROHIBITED. MASK must be in proper position throughout candidate's presence in the examination hall.
14. Before entry to the examination centre, the centre officials may assess the health condition of the candidate. All candidates MUST adhere to the COVID related protocols in compliance with the orders and directives of Government of India and local directives.
15. As per Govt. order, any candidate who is Covid-19 positive or has any other infectious disease, MUST NOT come out of home/hospital; and hence the entry for such candidate will be DENIED. Asymptomatic candidates, if any, who have temperature higher than 99.4°F, will be taken to ISOLATION area for the examination.
16. On the exam day, candidate must NOT have COVID symptoms, NOT in quarantine and was NOT in close contact with any COVID patient during the last fortnight.
17. Violation of any of the above guidelines including impersonation or breaking of code of conduct for GATE 2021 exam will lead to cancellation of candidature and legal action.

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The GATE 2021 score is calculated using the formula

$$GATE\ Score = S_q + (S_t - S_q) \frac{(M - M_q)}{(\bar{M}_t - M_q)}$$

where,  
**M** is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this GATE 2021 scorecard  
**M<sub>q</sub>** is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper  
 **$\bar{M}_t$**  is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)  
**S<sub>q</sub>** = 350, is the score assigned to **M<sub>q</sub>**  
**S<sub>t</sub>** = 900, is the score assigned to  **$\bar{M}_t$**

In the GATE 2021 score formula, **M<sub>q</sub>** is 25 marks (out of 100) or  $\mu + \sigma$ , whichever is greater. Here  $\mu$  is the mean and  $\sigma$  is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared in the paper.

Qualifying in GATE 2021 does not guarantee either an admission to a post-graduate program or a scholarship/assistantship. Admitting institutes may conduct further tests and interviews for final selection.
