

**Report on “Implementation of National Educational Policy (NEP)-2020-In
Higher Educational Institutions”**

The National Educational Policy 2020, outlines the vision of India's new education system. The new policy replaces the previous National Policy on Education. The policy is a comprehensive framework for elementary education to higher education as well as vocational training in both rural and urban India. The policy aims to transform India's education system. In this context, for creating Awareness on NEP-2020 among faculty members a one day seminar on “Implementation of National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020 in Higher Educational Institution” was conducted on 20-3-2021 in G.Narayanamma Institute of Technology & Science (For Women) under Faculty Development Program. Two sessions were conducted by two distinguished faculty from Osmania University and Hyderabad Central University in the forenoon and afternoon. Professor T.Mrunalini, Dean, Faculty of Education, Osmania University presented on “National Educational Policy preparing Young minds for future”. Session first started with vision of NEP-2020, followed by key principles of NEP. There was a detailed explanation on five pillars of NEP-Access, Equity, Affordability, Accountability, Quality. Next there was a detailed discussion on ten aspects of higher education like Quality Universities and colleges, towards more holistic and multidisciplinary education, Institutional restructuring etc. Prof. B. Raja Sekhar, Pro-vice chancellor of University of Hyderabad interacted with the staff members on ‘Implementation of National Educational Policy -- Pros and Cons’. He spoke in brief on all points of NEP-20 with examples, he has stressed on role of faculty in implementation and challenges, motivated, energized, capable faculty, vocational education, transforming of regulatory system of higher education, professional education, life-long

learning, technology use and integration etc. at the end all the staff members are expressed their satisfaction with two lectures. The seminar was very informative and entire presentation gave a clear idea on National Educational Policy-2020. Total 136 faculty from all departments of GNITS Attended the seminar with great Enthusiasm.
