Award Specifications & Renewal Terms for Graduate Awards

- You must be admitted to a degree program in the School of Computing and Engineering, and the award is renewable only for the degree and academic program for which you are admitted.
- The award is automatically renewed for subsequent semesters if you maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average, maintain full time enrollment, enroll in approved course work, and remain in good academic and disciplinary standing.
- You must enroll continuously in Fall and Spring semesters, enrolling in Summer Sessions is optional.
- A review for renewal is conducted at the end of each semester. Failure to meet automatic renewal requirements may result in the discontinuation of your award.
- You will only remain eligible for this scholarship as long as you are being assessed a non-resident tuition
- Your scholarship will be applied to your student account once you enroll at UMKC.
- You may accept scholarships from other sources in addition to this award.
- This award may not be combined with other financial support from the School of Computing and Engineering, including but not limited to student employment as a research assistant or teaching/ assistant.
