 - II. To ratify and approve the Titles of the Courses and Course structure of the following Courses offered by Discipline of English for all the branches of B. Tech as per GNR-22 Regulations.
 - a. English [ENG] – I Year
 - b. English Professional Communication Skills Laboratory [EPCS] - I Year
 - c. Employability and Soft Skills Lab [ESS Lab] - III Year
 - d. Gender Sensitization [GS] *Mandatory Course - II Year*
 - e. Human Values and Professional Ethics [HVPE] *Mandatory Course - I Year*
 - f. Constitution of India [COI] *Mandatory Course – II Year*
 - g. Behavioral Skills and Professional Communication [BSPC] *Open Elective – IV Year*

Following are the 'Minutes of the BOS Meeting, and the associated resolutions' for B.Tech Programme:

1. Dr. P. Aparna, BOS Chair, extended a cordial welcome to all the members of the BOS for Discipline of English and introduced all the members.
2. The proposed academic regulations of GNITS (GNR-22 Regulations) were presented.
3. After discussions, all the Members of the BOS for Discipline of English have unanimously approved the GNR-22 Academic Regulations.
4. The Four Year 8 Semester UG Degree Course Structure for B.Tech with a total of 160 Credits, as per contents was briefed to the members.
5. The BOS committee approved the BOS chair to present the details pertaining to course contents of all the Subjects/Courses related to the 1st and 2nd years of B.Tech degree course offered by Discipline of English for necessary approvals.
6. It was discussed and decided to prescribe the book titled: "**English: Language, Context and Culture**" by Orient BlackSwan Pvt. Ltd., as prescribed text book for **English for Skill Enhancement Course** for 1st year B.Tech.
7. The following titles for the Courses were discussed, modified and approved as stated below :
 - i. English for Skill Enhancement [ESE] – I Year
 - ii. English Language ^{and} Communication Skills Laboratory [ELCS] - I Year
 - iii. Advanced Communication Skills Lab [ACS Lab] - III Year

However, the titles of the following courses remain the same with no changes.


- i. Gender Sensitization [GS] – I Year

- vi. Advanced Communication Skills Lab [ACS Lab] - III Year








