

Measures taken by GNITS to curb Ragging in 2023-24

1. Constitution of anti-ragging Committee:

An anti-ragging Committee comprising faculty and students is constituted. Prof. Ch Ganapathy Reddy is the coordinator for this committee.

2. Formation of daily anti-ragging Squads:

Anti-ragging Squads headed by a senior faculty member were constituted which go round the campus and hostels daily from 3.30 - 4.30 pm under the supervision of Principal and Nodal officer.

3. Control of Lunch hour Ragging:

In order to minimize the interaction between the freshers and seniors, the lunch hours are staggered.

4. Counseling the senior students:

Briefing sessions were conducted by the HODs & the Anti-ragging committee members at the department level to all the senior students.

5. Undertakings from seniors:

Undertakings from all the II year students & their parents/guardians were obtained to the effect that they will not indulge in any kind of ragging activities both in the Institution as well as in the hostels.

6. Adequate publicity:

Anti-Ragging Posters depicting clauses & Punishments under Anti-Ragging Act are displayed at **all strategic points** in all the blocks of the Institution and also in the Hostels.

7. Counseling sessions for freshers:

All the classes of 1st year were addressed by the Nodal officer emphasizing the **measures being implemented** in the campus. They were informed about exclusive mail ID arc@gnits.ac.in.

8. Isolation of freshers:


A separate hostel has been demarcated exclusively for 1st year students to minimize the interaction between the freshers and seniors.

9. Surprise / random visits:

Surprise/random visits to hostels are taken up to ensure a ragging free and healthy atmosphere in the hostels.

11. Review meetings

Regular review meetings are being held to take stock of the developments in the Institution.
