



K Naga Bhavya Jyothi, of ECE department, GNITS, had graduated in 2016. During her 3rd year, she decided to prepare for GATE-2016 exam and gave the exam in her 4th year. She got the 943rd rank in her first attempt, thanks to her strategic plan of how to attempt a tough paper. This rank led to hopes of getting into the newer IITs and the old NITs. However, one of the HODs of GNITS advised herto take the exam that would be conducted by IITs during admissions for students closer to the 1000th rank so that she could get into one of the top IITs. She started attending the written exams and interviews in all the IITs. Despite the rejections she faced from most of the IITs, she got into one of the top IITs in India i.e., IIT Bombay. After stepping into IITB, she realised that there was a lot more for her to explore.

With the communication skills she developed in GNITS when she was herclass'representative, she landed in the publicity team of "Team SHUNYA, IIT Bombay" where she was participating in international competitions to design and build solar houses. Later, she became the lead for the electrical subsystem of the team and then rose to deputy project manager for the whole team consisting of 70+ interdisciplinary students and 8 faculty advisors. In 2018, the team received "Best Participation Award" in Solar Decathlon China conducted by US Department of Energy for building a modular solar house in 15 days in China. She then became the team lead for the next team participating in Solar Decathlon US Design Challenge, in 2021. Parallelly, she got selected to present herM. Tech project work in one of the prestigious conferences in solar field, Photovoltaics Specialist Conference in 2019 US. She was nominated for the "Best Poster Award" after which she decided to pursue her PhD in IIT Bombay. She is currently working at the National Centre for Photovoltaic Research and Education, IIT Bombay funded by MNRE, Govt of India to build an instrument for reliability test and also developing a standard for vehicle integrated photovoltaics.

She was honored with "Institute Technical Organizational Award" for her contribution in several technical activities as a representative of IIT Bombay in an international level. The team she was leading for US Design Challenge bagged the 2nd position in attached housing division worldwide. Currently, she is mentoring three national teams participating in Solar Decathlon India Design Challenge 2023. She is also mentoring an international team participating in Solar Decathlon US Build Challenge 2023. GNITS not only provided her with ample engineering skills but also moral values. Owing to the guidance from the professors, she was preparing for the GATE entrance exam, aiming to join IITs. However, she could not get that in her 3rd year, and did not have good IITs in her required stream in her final year. Then, she decided to sit down and prepare for GATE after her final year, as she realized that much of her time in college was spent on subjects and labs.

She joined as a Scientist/Engineer in Physical Research Laboratory in 2013. She was assigned the responsibility of operation and part of the instrument development team of the newly installed India's largest solar telescope, named Multi Application Solar Telescope (MAST), situated in lake Fateh Sagar, Udaipur. Her team got awarded with "ISRO Team Excellence Award" in the year 2017, for the project MAST. MAST telescope is a 50 cm solar telescope that gives high-resolution images of the sun, and also gives the doppler velocities and magnetic field of the sun.

She's also working with a group in the international project, Global Oscillation Network Group, where six similar instruments are installed around the world and one of them is at Udaipur, which studies Helioseismology on the sun. She's also working in the back-end instrument team of a newly proposed 2 m class solar telescope named "National Large Solar Telescope (NLST)".

Her team develops instruments to study the sun and different processes like solar flares and coronal mass ejections, which also impact different planets and satellites. In 2019, she completed her M. Tech in Embedded Systems from Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani, stood in the Top10 and got the opportunity to attend the convocation in BITS, Goa campus. Currently, she is planning to continue her research in Astronomy and Astrophysics. She got opportunities to publish 5 papers in international journals and 2 technical reports, and to guide 6 engineering students.

Apart from these, she practices yoga and participates in many sports and tournaments in the department of space, and won many prizes. She spends her time in social activities, being part of NGOs.




