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WHAT IS CYBER BULLYING ?

Cyber bullying can involve all three types of bullying and takes place online. This type of bullying is becoming more prevalent everyday. Examples includes :

- Hateful text messages or emails
- Rumors sent by email or posted on social media network.
- Embarrassing pictures, videos, website, or fake profiles posted online.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE BEING BULLIED?

Tell someone: Make sure you tell a trusted adult, such as a parent or teacher, and they will help you to decide what to do.

Report the person/group- Cyber bullying is never acceptable and you should report the content (pictures, text, group etc.) to someone you trust and to the social media site. All social networks such as Facebook, Twitter etc have report abuse buttons.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE BEING BULLIED?

Save the evidence: It is really important to have an evidence of the cyber bully to show it to the concerned authorities.

Block the person/group : Most social media sites will give you the option to block the person/group cyber bullying you.
